

SACS Reaffirmation Visit Spring 2013

Quality Enhancement Plan (QEP)



The *QEP topic* selection process:

A committee is appointed to represent a broad, cross-section of the campus community, including:

- Deans
- Department chairs
- Faculty
- College administrators

- a Staff representative
- the Student Government president
- Program directors



The committee charge:

- Recommend a topic for the University's QEP to the SACS Leadership Team and the University Cabinet.
- 2. <u>Build a consensus</u> for recommending a *topic* to the SACS Leadership Team that . . .



- a) Supports Trevecca's strategic plan
- b) Addresses an area of significant, evident need related to student learning
- c) Is measurable in terms of student learning outcomes
- d) Represents a course of action that is achievable within the resources of the University

- e) Has the support of key constituency groups (faculty, students, staff, administrators, Board of Trustees)
- f) Is selected after a broad institutional participation

The entire *QEP development process* will take 1½ -2 years and will involve most of the faculty and administrators before it is implemented after the SACS reaffirmation visit.

Beginning the process of topic selection . . .

- The faculty is asked to break into small groups to discuss possible QEP topics.
- Keep in mind the following:
 - > The *QEP topic* should derive from some form of assessment and is stronger when linked to the *formal assessment process*.
